



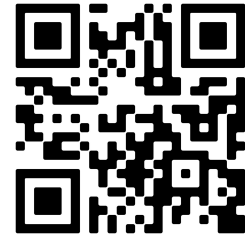

Community Hall Update - Honouring our Past, Building Our Future

Springbrook has always had a strong sense of community, from the early days as an air force base to many neighbourhood events that have brought families together over the years.

Many residents may remember when the Multiplex, owned then by Trinidad, was home to community favourites like the annual Halloween Party, Christmas Potluck, Easter Breakfast and so much more. When the building was sold, the SCA moved events to other buildings such as Building 7 or Building 14 (wherever we could afford to rent space and whatever was available). Harvard Park was later sold, so we adapted once again.

Today the Multiplex is available for us to rent, it is privately owned though and as history has shown, that access can change. None of Springbrook's existing buildings are designed as permanent gathering spaces for residents and none are fully accessible.

Our volunteers continue to work hard to bring events and programs to the community, often hauling supplies, cleaning items at home, and setting up from scratch. These efforts are a testament to Springbrook's incredible community spirit, but they also highlight why a dedicated, accessible hall is so important for the future.

We have launched a "Friday Fun Fact" series on our social media pages. Follow along, together we will celebrate our past while planning for a space that will serve future generations.
